Clear Mountain Energy Center, LLC, a Savion project, is developing a large-scale ground-mount solar photovoltaic facility in Clermont County, Ohio, near the village of Williamsburg. The project will potentially power the equivalent of 21,600 Ohio households by delivering 100 MW of clean, domestic energy.

Clear Mountain Energy Center will serve the local power grid by interconnecting to the Cedarville-Ford 138 kV line. Project facilities will be located on approximately 700 acres of privately-owned land, on which a wide range of environmental and engineering surveys and studies were completed in 2022 and 2023 to ensure a project design that minimizes impact on the local community and its resources.

Outreach to local officials and stakeholders began in late 2020, and an introductory community meeting was held in August 2022. The first of two public information meetings took place in March 2023, and the project plans to apply to the Ohio Power Siting Board in Q2 2023 for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need to construct the project.

Project Benefits

Clear Mountain Energy Center has the potential to create a large influx of tax revenue benefitting Clermont County, local school districts, and the broader community, including:



\$900,000 estimated in new annual tax revenue during operations amounting to \$31.5 million estimated in new tax revenue over the expected 35-year operating life of the project.



Millions of dollars in new local earnings during construction and millions of dollars in new local long-term earnings in Clermont County and the surrounding area.



More than 150 new construction jobs during the 12–18 month construction phase.

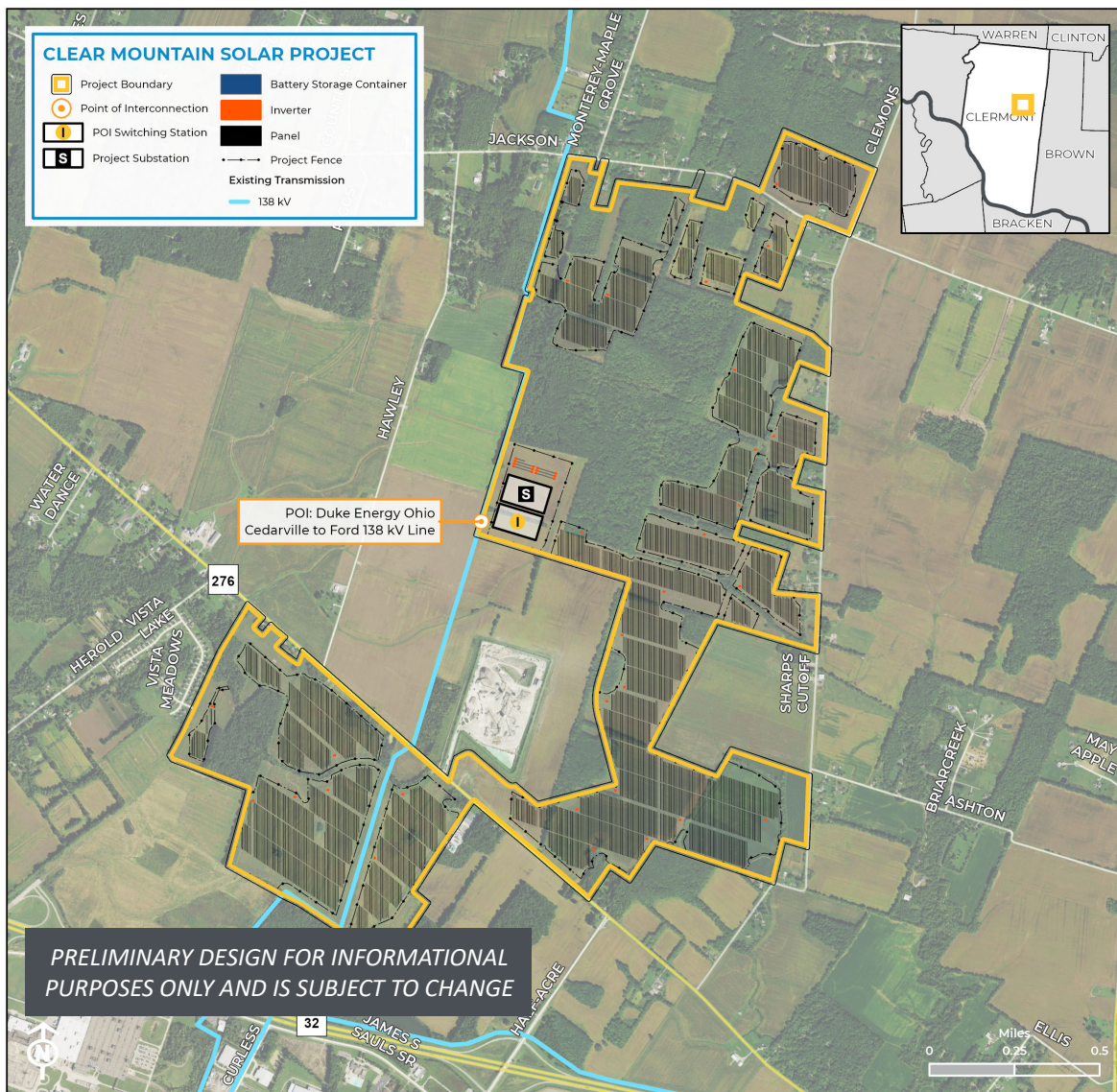
Community Outreach
