

## **Clear Mountain Energy Center**

Clear Mountain Energy Center, LLC, a Savion project, is developing a large-scale ground-mount solar photovoltaic facility in Clermont County, Ohio, at the intersection of Jackson, Williamsburg, and Batavia Townships. The project will power the equivalent of 21,600 Ohio households by delivering 100 MW of clean, domestic energy.

Clear Mountain Energy Center will serve the local power grid by interconnecting to the Cedarville-Ford 138 kV line. All components and infrastructure necessary for the project will occupy approximately 565 acres of privately owned land, on which a wide range of environmental and engineering surveys and studies were completed to ensure an optimal design and minimal impact on the surrounding community.

Outreach to local officials and stakeholders began in late 2020, and an introductory community meeting was held in August 2022 with two follow-up public information meetings in March and October of 2023. The project applied to the Ohio Power Siting Board in January 2024 for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need to construct the project, and, upon approval, is slated to begin construction in 2025 with a projected commercial operation date of Q4 2026.

Clear Mountain Energy Center will create a broad range of community benefits, including:



\$939,000+ estimated in new annual tax revenue during operations amounting to \$32.9 million total over the expected 35-year operating life of the project.



Millions of dollars in new local earnings during construction and millions of dollars in new local long-term earnings in Clermont County and the surrounding area.



More than 150 new construction jobs during the 12–18 month construction phase.



Agrivoltaics research and demonstration program that will demonstrate agriculturally-compatible solar in partnership with local farmers and organizations.
